What's included

Accommodation

The Holiday Inn Express & Suites Tremblant, renovated a few years ago, sits just a stone's throw away from the slopes in the Tremblant village. Skiers and snowboarders of all levels enjoy breathtaking views of the Laurentians, with a ski area composed of 96 trails on four different mountainsides. All rooms have a microwave and a mini-refrigerator to store snacks and refreshments. Complimentary Wi-Fi, sauna, outdoor whirlpool, fitness room. Triple or double occupancy room options are offered. A triple room will be 2 double beds + 1 sofa bed. A double room will be 2 double beds.

Lift Tickets

2 day lift tickets are included.

IKON pass holders may use their IKON pass instead of 2 day lift tickets for a reduction of \$140.

Meals

2 full hot/cold breakfast buffet each morning to get your ski day started. *Note: Breakfast could be picked up and taken to your room depending on hotel health and safety protocols.*

Restaurants in the Village for lunch and dinner, at your own cost.

Departure

On Friday, March 24, 2023, from Yonge & York Mills, Toronto at 3:00 pm and at 3:30 pm from Scarborough. On Sunday, March 26, 2023, from Mont Tremblant at 4:00 pm.

To Mont-Tremblant and return will be by HPSC luxury coach.
