Accommodation

The Holiday Inn Express & Suites Tremblant, renovated a few years ago, sits just a stone's throw away from the slopes in the Tremblant village. Skiers and snowboarders of all levels enjoy breathtaking views of the Laurentians, with a ski area composed of 96 trails on four different mountainsides. Hotel suites are 1 bedroom with 2 double beds, sitting area and a full kitchen, coffee maker, stove, and utensils, to prepare meals and store snacks and refreshments. Hotel rooms are 2 double beds or 1 queen bed with microwave and mini-refrigerator to store snacks and refreshments. Complimentary Wi-Fi, sauna, outdoor whirlpool, fitness room. A triple room will be 2 double beds + 1 sofa bed.

Lift Tickets

2-day lift tickets are included.

IKON pass holders may use their IKON pass instead of 2-day lift ticket for a reduction of \$120.

Meals

Hot/cold breakfast each morning. Restaurants in the Village for lunch and dinner, at your own cost.
