Enjoy this true ski-in, ski-out resort at 1600 metres (5200 feet) and soaring to 3250 metres (10600 feet) with 264 ski runs and 130 lifts.

Hit the slopes by day and dine on French Savoyard specialty meals by night. This is an all-inclusive Club Med resort experience with food, refreshments, entertainment, ski guides, great skiing. Rejuvenate in the heated indoor-outdoor pool (included) or enjoy spa services if you choose (extra cost).

What's included

Accommodation

The Club Med village is located at 1600 metres (5200 feet). La Vanoise main dining room in mountain style décor provides a wide variety of cuisine, and the specialty restaurant The Pierra Menta offers Savoyard dishes in a cozy atmosphere. The lounge/bar, The Aiguille Grive, provides a variety of options to suit your mood. Sit out on the panoramic terrace for stunning views or find a snug spot in one of the cozy lounges and just chill. If you're in the mood to party, the dance floor keeps up the pace well into the night! The resort has a large heated indoor/outdoor pool perfect for relaxing after a day on the slopes.

Rooms: Junior family superior room can accommodate a maximum of 2 adults. Beds can either be 1 large or split into 2 singles. Bedding preference to be confirmed with trip leader.

Baggage Fees: (subject to change)

Air Canada is not currently charging for the first bag or ski equipment, but this needs to be confirmed with the airline closer to departure date. Skis and boots are considered 1 pc even if in separate bags as long as nothing else is in the bags. This aspect of the trip is beyond the control of the tour operator or HPSC, and is subject to change by the airline up until airline tickets are issued.

Airport and Land Transfers:

Return ground transfers from airport to accommodation, organized by Club Med. Note that these are not dedicated HPSC buses but someone from the trip will be designated to assemble the group to meet the Club Med buses at the airport.

What you should know and fine print

Passport / Travel Documents

Canadian citizens need a Canadian passport that is valid until at least 6 months after the scheduled return date. Other nationalities may require different documents. It is necessary for such people to advise their nationality at the time of booking so that we can determine what travel documents they will require in order to participate in this trip. For all nationalities, please note that entry to another country may be refused even if the required information and travel documents are complete.

Note: Members are solely responsible to ensure that their travel documents are complete, valid and in order.

Cancellation Policy as set by Tour Operator

Cancellation Policies are set by the Tour Operators, not HPSC. Please consider your commitment carefully before booking your trip.

- \$ \$100 Online Registration Deposit due at time of booking. Non refundable.
- \$700 Tour Operator Deposit + cost of insurance (if taken) payable at time of booking. Non refundable.
- Balance due: November 1, 2023. Non refundable.
- Important: If you need to cancel and you have found a substitution by November 1, a \$100.00 plus 13% HST fee will apply and is paid by the person who is cancelling. Name changes are not permitted after November 1, 2023. Refund for the cancelling member will be the amount paid to the tour operator less substitution fee of \$100 + HST. The HPSC \$100 registration deposit is not refundable.

Travel Insurance

Members are responsible for arranging their own trip cancellation insurance and medical insurance. On all out-of country trips, health coverage in case of sickness or injury is strongly recommended

Optional travel insurance is available through Merit Travel, our tour operator. Comprehensive travel Insurance protects non-refundable payments in the event that participants are forced to cancel their vacation prior to departure or interrupt vacation due to medical reasons. "Cancel for Any Reason" coverage can be added to a newly purchased





policy. The premium is due with the deposit to the tour operator. Insurance payments must accompany the deposit in order to be valid. Cost of insurance varies per person. **To get the proper quote you must specify your full name, age, DOB, mailing address, phone number, email address, the options chosen and total trip cost.** After you have registered, paid the \$100 non-refundable deposit and completed Stage-2 of the registration procedure, you will contact the Tour Operator for a quote.

Merit Travel offers trip cancellation insurance with Allianz Global Assist and a "Cancel For Any Reason" rider can be added for an additional 25% supplement. This allows cancellation for any reason up to 7 days prior to receive a refund of 75% of the prepaid travel arrangements, and from 6 days to 48 hours for a refund of 75% up to a maximum of \$1,500.00, and within 48 hours the cancellation must be for medical reasons only for any refund. "Cancel for any reason" rider must be purchased at the time of deposit.

Insurance is non-refundable from date of issuance. Please note that any unused portion of a ski trip will not be refunded as per conditions above. Passengers must submit a claim to their insurance company if they cancel after the above dates.

The Fine Print

Tickets are 100% non-refundable once issued. Name changes and deviations are not permitted once ticketed. Individuals must ensure that all names are spelled correctly and match their personal identification on their passport. The Tour Operator and Airline will not be held liable for delays or cancellations caused by strikes, labor disputes, government actions, weather or any cause beyond the Tour Operator's or Airline's control. The Airline reserves the right to change equipment or schedules. The customer hereby releases and waives any claims against the Airline and Tour Operator regarding cancellation or schedule changes.

All applicable fuel surcharges and taxes in effect as of June have been included in the package price. However in these volatile times the tour operator reserves the right to charge for unanticipated increases in the cost of fuel and taxes imposed by the resort or airline.
