Downhill Ski and Snowboard Trip

The charming, nearby gold-rush town of Rossland has been voted as 'Canada's #1 Ski Town by USA Today and Canada's premier outdoor town by Explore Magazine. The boutique Josie hotel offers ski in/out access, crackling firepits, a fitness facility, ski valet, Wifi and on site restaurant, lounge and spa.

Stylishly appointed rooms featuring a 1 King or 2 queen beds, relaxation area and bathroom with all the modern luxuries.

A hot buffet breakfast is included for the group on the first day, but after that members can purchase their own breakfast from the menu at the resort.

Baggage Fees: (subject to change)

- ^{\$\psi\$} 1st bag is free up to 23 kg for the group (per direction, including taxes). Those booked separately from the group will pay \$30 + HST for the 1st bag (per direction, including taxes).
- 2nd bag \$50 + HST (per direction, including taxes).

Air Canada considers skis and boots as 1 piece even if in separate bags as long as nothing else is in the bags. (Subject to change, check with the airline.) Payable directly to the airline at time of check in.

Deviation charges:

Any person deviating from the group itinerary for the return flight only will be charged \$50 CAD plus tax and any additional charges imposed by the suppliers and airlines and are subject to change. Deviations are strictly on a request basis. Members must abide by the prearranged transfer dates and times or arrange their own transfers at their own cost. Resort Info

Red Mountain is situated in BC's Kootenay Mountains, on the Powder highway. It offers massive terrain, and is known for its 300" of annual snowfall, much of it powder. There is a local shuttle bus that runs between Red Mountain ski resort and the town of Rossland. Rossland is a charming full service ski town with restaurants, shops and more. You will stay slope side at the lururious Josie Hotel with ski in/out access.

Passport / Travel Documents

Canadian Citizens: Travelling within Canada – PHOTO ID is a requirement to board all aircraft.

Note: Members are solely responsible to ensure that their travel documents are sufficient, valid and in order.

Cancellation Policy

Cancellation Policies are set by the Tour Operators, not HPSC. Please consider your commitment carefully before booking your trip.

- Your deposits (\$100 + \$500) and any Insurance Premium paid are non-refundable.
- From December 5, 2023 to departure, 100% of holiday cost is non-refundable.
- Single Supplement charge is non-refundable unless a substitute is found.
- All paid for deviation or change administration fees are non-refundable.
- Any unused portion of a ski trip will not be refunded. Passengers must go through insurance, if applicable.



Optional Travel Insurance

Skican strongly recommends the purchase of trip cancellation insurance to protect non-refundable deposits and payments in the event participants are forced to cancel their vacation for medical reasons. Trip organizers are responsible for communicating the availability of Comprehensive Insurance to all participants. 'Cancel for Any Reason' coverage can also be added to a newly purchased policy. The premium is due with the deposit. A package plan can be purchased through Skican for participants, please contact your Skican group coordinator for rates.

Comprehensive Travel Insurance is available to protect non-refundable payments in the event that participants are forced to cancel their vacation prior to departure or interrupt vacation due to medical reasons. "Cancel for Any Reason" coverage can be added to a newly purchased policy. The premium is due with the deposit to the tour operator. Insurance payments must accompany the deposit in order to be valid. Cost of insurance varies per person. To get the proper quote you must specify your name, age, DOB, mailing address, phone number, email address, the options chosen and total trip cost. After you have registered, paid the \$100 non-refundable deposit and completed Stage-2 of the registration procedure, you will contact the Tour Operator for a quote.

The Fine Print

Tickets are 100% non-refundable once issued. Name changes and deviations are not permitted once ticketed. Individuals must ensure that all names are spelled correctly and match their personal identification on their passport. The Tour Operator and Airline will not be held liable for delays or cancellations caused by strikes, labour disputes, government actions, weather or any cause beyond the Tour Operator's or Airline's control. The Airline reserves the right to change equipment or schedules. The customer hereby releases and waives any claims against the Airline and Tour Operator regarding cancellation or schedule changes.

\$10 per run - Inbounds Mt. Kirkup CAT:

Grey Mountain is the pickup area for RED's \$10/run cat skiing operation that shuttles powder hounds up to the top of Mt Kirkup to shred 1,600 feet of vertical and nearly 200 acres that isn't chair accessible. The best part is that the end of your run takes you right back to the Grey chairlift.
